Our Key Messages:

Politicians of the future will:

1. Commit to finding solutions as a nation by including our First Nations Peoples.
2. Include climate justice in the national curriculum more explicitly and extensively.
3. Achieve a carbon neutral Australia by 2030.
4. Dedicate resources to upskill workers to nurture a carbon neutral workforce.
5. Encourage Federal, State and local Governments to take further action to reduce waste, provide effective recycling and provide education for the community on sustainable practices.
6. Introduce legislation to drastically limit unnecessary single use plastics.
7. Research alternative energy solutions and make a shift towards existing renewable energy solutions.
8. Commit to cleaner waterways.
9. Meaningfully engage with the public on climate justice issues and commit to acting on their concerns.

Example of weekly activities

Water

- If your school has a local waterway that is often left polluted with waste, organise a group to clean up the area during
- Hold a virtual petition signing. You may want to sign this petition to end single use plastics:

- Add goal 6 and 14 of the SDGs as an agenda item on assembly.

Waste

- Organise a group to visit the local recycling facility.
- Work with your tuckshop to see if you can hold an entirely waste free lunch.
- Find out where the recycling from your home/school ends up.
- Add goal 12 of the SDGs as an agenda item on assembly.

Energy

- Host a local politician for a Q&A about the future of clean energy in Australia. If your school is doing online learning, maybe you can host a Q&A via Zoom.
- Go electricity free for an hour during the school day.
- Add goal 7 of the SDGs as an agenda item on assembly.

Emissions
